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


Be aware! Scam artists are at it again. Nationally, it has been reported that people have had their personal information stolen, and then had their

Social Security benefit re-routed to a debit card that the fraudster has control of. Be vigilant! If your direct deposit of your Social Security benefit doesn't arrive when it should--contact the Social Security Administration

immediately to determine its whereabouts. Additionally, if you receive mail from the Social Security Administration, open it promptly in case it is a confirmation notice or a re-routing of your benefit that you did not authorize.

Our Debit Cards have a new daily limit when using the credit option. The former limit of \$500.00 per day has been raised to \$1000.00 per day. (The limit with PIN usage remains the same at no more than 2 usages in 24 hours for no more than \$200.00.) Remember--avoid PIN usage fees and always use the credit option when there is no cash involved in your purchase!

Address Change Reminder!

Going somewhere for the winter? Or perhaps your relocation is more permanent. Whatever the case, your Straits Area Federal Credit Union statements and financial products such as check reorders, debit/credit card renewals, and your 1099 statement are not forwarded. Please take a moment to complete a change of address form with us (and the Post Office too!) thus ensuring that you still receive these items. If you have an alternate phone number while you're away, please include that as well, so we could contact

you quickly if necessary. Please also fill out a "Debit Card Use Out of the Area" form, so that our Fraud Department doesn't think a thief took your card on a wild cross-country ride, and a quick call to our Visa Department at 1-800-828-3901 will inform them of your travel plans as well. These preventative steps should help you avoid the inconvenience of having your cards blocked due to unusual activity, and ensure that your financial statements and products follow you wherever you go.

If you'd like to get the jump on Christmas 2014, just come in and see one of our tellers after November 1st. You can save as much or as little as you'd like, but the savings really do add up. If you save just \$5.00 weekly for 52 weeks you'd have \$260.00. \$10.00 saved weekly would yield \$520.00 and \$20.00 saved weekly would bring you \$1040.00.
